● SKYGUIDE : THE CHALLENGE

Skyguide manages flight traffic on behalf of the Swiss Confederation and ensures the safety of the most complex airspace in Europe. The staff-side requirement was to gain access to their mail and agenda as well as to the organisation's intranet application from any given workstation. The actual challenge for Skyguide was to provide each person with full access to all information that could be reached via an Internet connection. Air control staff for instance needed to be able to consult their timetables and to access company data via the intranet.

The ease-of-use factor weighed very strongly among applicable criteria when it came to choosing a particular technology.

● BEE WARE : THE SOLUTION

For several years to date Skyguide has been working with eXpert-Solutions, an organisation specialising in information security, that also presents Bee Ware technology among its solutions. As a certified partner of Bee Ware, eXpert-Solutions took charge of the project management as well as the integration of the chosen technology into the systems of the Swiss air navigation service provider.

Since the Spring of 2005 Skyguide has thus been using Bee Ware Intelliwall technology. This is a global solution deploying 2 modules, i-Sentry and i-Trust. The former ensures high security on the systems via sophisticated intrusion detection mechanisms on HTTP and HTTPS traffic. The latter is a Web Single Sign On module providing single logins across all sites and domains.

The process is extremely simple: the user signs on his name and password. He receives (by e-mail or SMS) a PIN code within the next few seconds. All he then needs to do is to enter this code into the system.
